4. List the three things that are to be done “in secret” from Mt 6.
5. Jesus instructs about “worry” in chapter 6. What are you *not* supposed to worry about?
What are you supposed to seek first instead?
6. According to Mt 7, who will enter the kingdom of heaven?
7. When Jesus completed this teaching at the end of Mt 7, what was the reaction of the crowds?
How is his teaching different from other teaching that they have heard?
